MEMBERS GUIDELINES FOR 2024

Welcome to the 2024 golf season!

SIGN UP for TEE TIMES:

•Sign up for your weekly tee times on our CMTL website. Click on Website Instructions located on the bottom left of the home page for instructions of how to sign up. Cutoff for signing up is 8 days before the date you wish to golf.

RULES:

•Players must play 12 games in order to retain membership in the club. Weekly attendance will be kept. Please notify the Membership Chair in writing if an extended medical leave is required.

•Weekly tee times will be posted on our website on Tuesdays, one week before your next play day. Tee time starts: 8:00 am Spring (April to end of May and Sept/Oct) 7:30 am Summer (June, July and August)

Cancelling after tee times are posted:

•If you are unable to play after Draw is posted, please call the CMTL phone line at 604-216-7333 and leave a message to inform that you are cancelling. We need to know of any changes by 9:00 am on Saturday morning before the upcoming Tuesday play day.

Cancelling after Final Draw is posted:

•By noon on Saturday, the "Final Draw" will be posted on the CM website for the next Tuesday's golf day. Check the Country Meadows website on the Saturday prior to the next Tuesday golf for your FINAL tee time. •If you have reason to cancel after the Saturday cutoff, you will need to call the Pro Shop at 604-241-4653. Country Meadows asks you to cancel no less than 24 hours in advance of your tee time with the exceptions being you have an emergency on Tuesday morning or the monsoons hit. •No shows may be charged if they do not call to cancel.

DAY of PLAY:

•Be **READY TO PLAY 30 minutes PRIOR** to your tee time. If you are late and your group has teed off, you will be added to a group where possible.

•Pay your green fees in the Pro Shop. Payment must be by debit or credit only.

•Scoring

You will need TWO scorecards (available when you pay in the Pro Shop). A copy of a completed scorecard is posted on the Bulletin Board outside the Pro Shop for your reference.

On ONE Scorecard

- Put your FULL Name & Division along the bottom portion of the card. •
- Put your Name under the RED portion on first line on the left side where you will be keeping your score.
- Your Handicap goes in the "second" square in from the right side of the card. You can find your • current handicap listed on the bulletin board outside the Pro Shop.
- Trade this filled out card with your "playing partner" you will keep your partner's score on their scorecard. They will keep your score on your card.
- Once you agree at the end of the game on the total score, you "attest" your partner's card (on left "vertical" side of the card) and hand this card in to be recorded.

On the SECOND scorecard:

- You keep your own score on this card so at the end you add up your score to see that it matches what you told your partner to track
- You will take this card home to enter your score into the computer in Golf Canada every time you play to keep your handicap current.

•At the first tee box you will see a Marshal who will check your name on his Draw sheet. **ONLY the Marshal can move members around.**

•To prevent slow play on the course, please keep in mind you must keep up to the group in front of you. The group behind should not be waiting with you at the tee box! The first two golfers to putt out, should move to the next tee.

AFTER THE ROUND:

•When you have finished your game, you and your partner will total and compare your scores. Complete your scorecard by signing it and your partner will sign your card to attest your score (on the left "vertical side").

•Drop off your scorecard in the correct division bin on a table located outside across from the Pro Shop

•IMPORTANT: Remember to **post your score HOLE-BY-HOLE on the GOLF CANADA website!** Take note of any changes to your handicap and make the change on our Country Meadows Ladies website.

•Record Birdies, Chip-Ins and HOLE-IN-ONE in binder located on outside table.
